I am two months into the six-month program, and to say that it's an amazing program would be an understatement.

For starters, receiving the funds allowed me to participate in the program without having to worry about the financial cost.

The program itself is very time-intensive, but a program that is worth every minute. So far, I have built relationships with a whole new network of people and learned more about my leadership style. In addition, I have started the process of learning all parts, from the government to culture to education to workforce, and more that make my city such a great place. We have been given access to thought leaders and organizations that I wouldn't have been able to do on my own.

As a member of the 2022 class, I have the opportunity to co-chair our class project. For the project, we will be helping to make capital improvements to an education center in St Pete that helps connect disadvantaged students to the water surrounding us and inspires girls to pursue careers in STEM.

KNOW Cares goals for 2022 is to research and partner with a nonprofit that specializes in building schools across the globe. By partnering with an organization to build a school for girls in a developing country, KNOW Cares is helping to ensure access to educational opportunities to the next generation of women leaders.
